

2010 EAST COAST CR 914 REGATTA SERIES

This new series will start with three regattas in the series:

All regattas MUST be two day events.

High Score total for all Regattas will determine the individual winner.

SERIES AWARDS

1. The overall winner will be presented a perpetual trophy at the end of the Series. The trophy will be returned to the Score Keeper (Brian Jobson) prior to or at the last event of the series.

EAST COAST CR 914 REGATTA RULES

1. Only regattas scheduled prior to the start of the season shall qualify.
 - i. Qualifying regattas will be listed on the class web site and the listing will note they are part of the Regatta Series
 - ii. Last minute regattas for locals only will not qualify.
2. All CR 914 skippers are eligible.
3. There is no entry fee or registration. If you race in one or more of the scheduled regattas, you will be automatically scored.

Scoring:

4. Each entrant in a regatta that actually starts at least one heat gets 5 points for their entry. No shows, get no points.
5. Each entrant gets 1 point for each boat they beat. If you win a 20 boat regatta, you get 19 points, 2nd = 18 etc. Last place only receives the 5 points for entering.
6. The winner of each event gets an additional 5 bonus points.
Second place gets 4 bonus points.
Third gets 3 bonus points.
Fourth gets 2 bonus points.
Fifth gets 1 bonus point.

[Example: If you win a 20-boat regatta you get 5 points for entering, plus 19 points for beating 19 boats, plus 5 points for finishing first. Thus your point total for that event would be 29.]

7. In the event of ties, the highest score for each captain in a regatta he actually sailed in will be used to break ties. Points RDs and staff members received shall not be used to break ties. If there are still ties the AMYA tie breaking system will be used.
8. The Regatta Director and any of his staff that would normally sail in the event will be awarded 1 point for each boat entered and 5 points for administrating the event.
9. In the event the RD and/or some of the staff also sail in the event, they shall be awarded points like all the other entrants.
10. An RD or staff member may only receive points for administrating one event per season. For all other events in the series that they administrate they shall receive 5 points.
